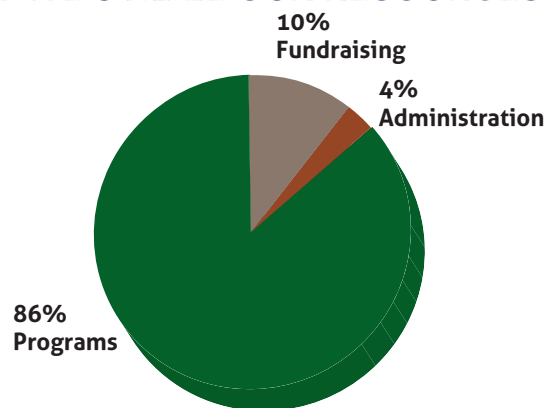


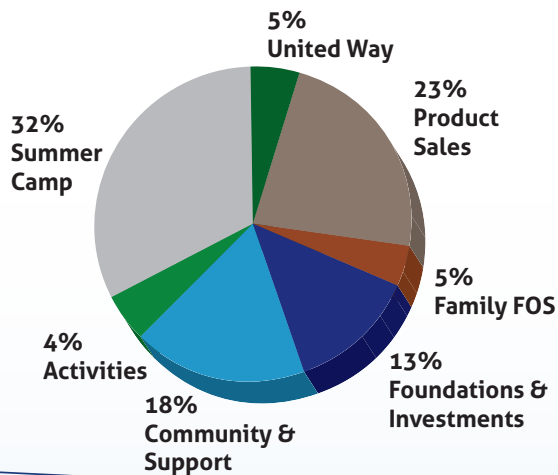
YOUR DONATION STAYS WITHIN OUR COMMUNITY

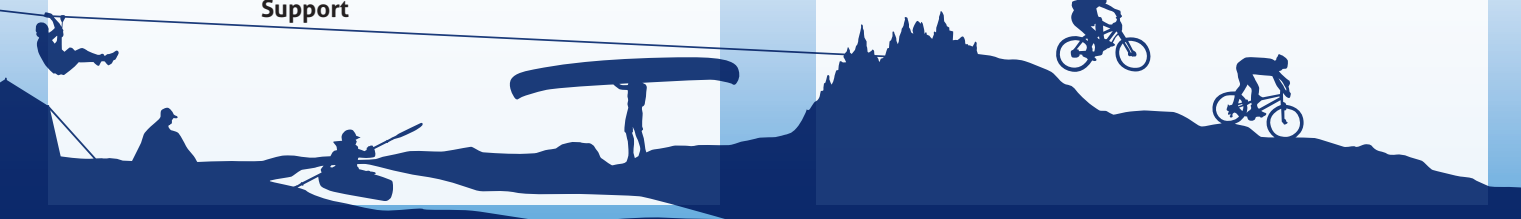
